

# **Register and Vote in Monroe County** 2024 – Primary Election - 2024

## You have the right to vote in Indiana if you . . .

- 1. Are a U.S. citizen and a resident of Indiana.
- 2. Are at least 18 years old on or before the next general or municipal election.
- 3. Are currently not in prison after being convicted of a crime.
- Have lived in your current precinct for at least 30 days prior to the election. (If you have moved within 30 days of the election, vote at your former precinct, either inperson or by mail.)
- 5. Are registered to vote.

### You may <u>register</u> online, in person, or by mail. Registration must be received at Monroe County Election Central by April 9 at noon for the Primary Election.

Through Tue. April 9, noon	Voter registration
Thur. April 25 by 11:59 pm	Application for absentee ballots due at Election Central.
Tues. April 9 – Fri. May 2 Weekdays from 8 am – 6 pm	Early voting & drop off absentee ballots at Election Operations (302 S. Walnut).
Sat. April 27, May 4 9 am – 4 pm Mon. May 6 8 am - Noon	Note: The voter, members of the voter's family, or a power-of-attorney are the only persons allowed to drop off a ballot. Anyone, other than the voter, who brings in a ballot must confirm their compliance by completing Form ABS-19.
Mon. May 6, noon	Mailed absentee ballots due at Election Central.
	Absentee ballots can also be dropped off at Poll Site.
Tue. May 7 🔹 6 am – 6 pm	PRIMARY ELECTION – Vote at poll site.
